

Virtual Annual General Meeting of Shareholders - Participant Guide

No matter where you are, or which device you use, you can easily access the virtual shareholders meeting.

You do not have to download or install anything to access your Annual General Meeting webcast.

Attending the virtual Meeting

All shareholders and guests can attend and view the live webcast. Only registered shareholders and duly appointed proxyholders (including non-registered shareholders who have duly appointed themselves as proxyholders) will be able to ask questions and vote at the meeting.

Authentication

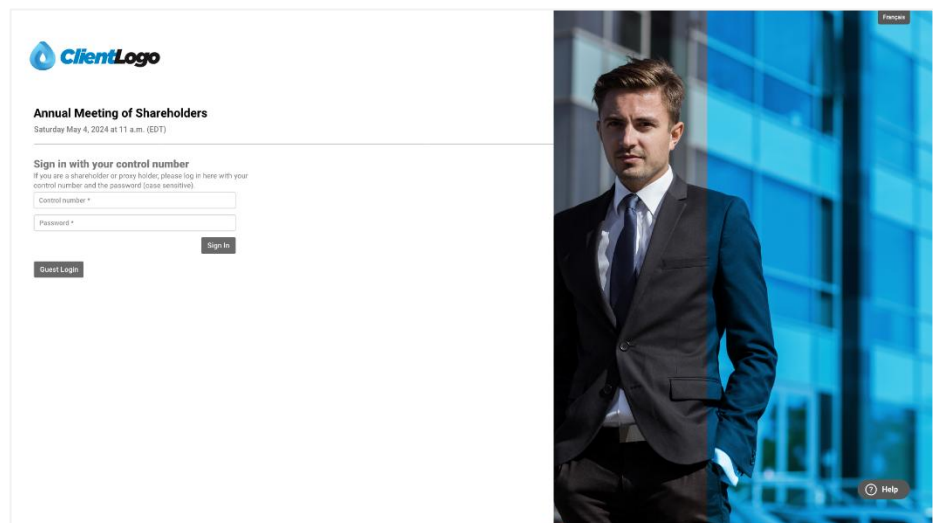
Log in to the meeting 15 minutes beforehand: <https://www.icastpro.ca/h2icgf>

Enter the control number found on the proxy form or in the email sent by the scrutineer, along with the password **CRCD2026** (case-sensitive), in the shareholder login window.

If you are a duly appointed proxyholder enter your control number and the password **CRCD2026** provided via email, into the Shareholder login section.

If you are a guest, complete the guest login information.

Follow the instructions to access the virtual meeting



1. Live technical support

If you have any technical difficulties, click on the Help button. A technician will answer you live in the language of your choice: French or English.

2. Submitting questions *(registered shareholders and duly appointed proxyholders)*

During the meeting, use the Question box provided on your screen to submit your questions.

3. Downloading

To save the PDF presentation to your device, click the Download button and select Open or Save As on your browser.

4. Voting

To vote, select one of the voting options and click “Vote”.

A confirmation message will also appear to show your vote has been received and the number of resolutions for which you have voted is displayed at the bottom of the screen.
